

BLS (Basic Life Support) Provider Course - Initial

The American Heart Association's BLS Provider Initial Course is for new health care providers and for those who do not have a current AHA BLS card. It will teach CPR and the use of the AED for all ages, as well as other lifesaving skills, in a wide variety of in-hospital and out-of-hospital settings.
