

Heartsaver® CPR AED Course

The American Heart Association's Heartsaver® CPR AED Course is designed for lay rescuers and those who have a duty to respond to emergencies because of job responsibilities or regulatory requirements. This course will teach CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) and the use of an AED (automated external defibrillator) for adults and children. The skills of infant CPR are taught upon request. A course completion card will be issued upon successful completion of the course requirements.
