PURPOSE:

This series has been designed to provide urologists and other interested healthcare providers with recent developments in the field of Urology.

OBJECTIVES:

At the conclusion of the monthly **Grand Rounds in Urology**, physician participants will be able to provide objective evidence of practical improvement in their evaluation and management with specific urological entities. Measurable teaching objectives will be specified for each presentation.

At the conclusion of each weekly Clinical Rounds in Urology, the physician participants will be able to:

For Urologic Rounds in Radiology: Identify clinically relevant radiographic aspects of recent urological cases.

For Journal Club: A review of recently published literature in urology and urological cancer for evaluation and potential incorporation into practice.

For Urologic Rounds in Pathology and Tumor Board: Analyze the clinically relevant pathologic aspects of recent urological cases.

For Urologic Rounds in Performance Improvement: Make constructive recommendations for effective improvements in the delivery of urological healthcare, both in office practice and for hospitalized patients.

At the conclusion of the visiting professor activity the participants should be able to:

1. Explain possible complications during kidney transplant, as well as management options for those issues.
2. Describe technical modifications that can improve outcomes in robotic simple prostatectomy.
3. Discuss the evolution of treatment for stress urinary incontinence in women.
4. List benefits of the newest imaging technologies, and describe the place of these technologies in the operating room.
5. Review possible therapies and outcomes for patients suffering from failed pediatric hypospadias treatment.
6. Cite updated clinical guidelines regarding vaginal mesh surgery.
